

SUPERMODERN Promotional Programme and Gold Police Star Award Regulations

for the Participants in EUROPOLTECH 2019, the International Fair of Technology
and Equipment for the Police and National Security Services

I. General Provisions

1. These Regulations are binding to the Participants in the Gold Police Star Award competition (hereunder referred to as the Award) organised as part of the EUROPOLTECH 2019 International Fair of Technology and Equipment for the Police and National Security Services, hereunder referred to as the Fair, and the SUPERMODERN 2019 Promotional Programme.
2. Entry submission to the SUPERMODERN Programme entails its automatic submission to the Gold Police Star Award. All products submitted to the SUPERMODERN Programme automatically become candidates to the Award.
3. The mission of the Programme and the Award is to promote technological development and technical progress in equipment and technology for the police and national security services.
4. A SUPERMODERN 2019 Application Form shall constitute an integral part hereof.

II. Terms & Conditions of Participation

1. EUROPOLTECH 2019 Exhibitors are eligible for the Award.
2. **The Application Form shall be sent by March 31, 2019, by email to europoltech@mtgsa.com.pl** – text in Word format, graphics in JPG format, including:
 - a. **information about the product presented at Europoltech, to be published (in the Exhibitor Catalogue, on the website and in the leaflet).** The description of the products will be published in the SUPERMODERN section of the Exhibitor Catalogue. The text of the description in Polish and English should include the Exhibitor's name, the product name, the product's applications and operational features. Length of the texts – up to 80 words in the Polish and English version,
 - b. **abbreviated information about the product to be displayed on its info plate.** The text for the plate should be submitted in Polish and English and include details of the product's operational and technical assets and the number of the Exhibitor's stand where the product's details are available. Please find attached: a specimen to help you prepare the text for the plate and the Regulations of the SUPERMODERN Promotional Programme.
3. A SUPERMODERN and Award entry fee of EUR 50, plus the VAT due, shall be paid by March 31, 2019.
4. Exhibits entered for the Programme will be displayed at a special exhibition organised as part of EUROPOLTECH.
5. **The exhibits can take the following form: the original product, a dummy display item, a multimedia presentation, or a mock-up (for large-sized products).**

6. The exhibits shall be delivered to the EUROPOLTECH Reception Desk the day before the Fair's opening, between 14:00 and 20:00. The exhibits can be collected back on the last day of the Fair – after 16:00 hrs.
7. MTG S.A. shall provide security for the SUPERMODERN Exhibition from the moment the exhibits are delivered to the moment they are collected.
8. Your submission of the Application Form is tantamount to the acceptance of the terms and conditions of the Award and the Regulations.
9. The preparation and delivery of exhibits shall be carried out at the expense and risk of the Award Participant.
10. **Assessment criteria. The Gold Police Star award shall be granted to products (equipment/technology):**
 - which are of the greatest usefulness to the police and national security services, respond to the current and prospective needs and requirements of all services,
 - which support task performance, increase operational efficiency and intensify the safety of officers and soldiers,
 - are distinguished by their novel technical and technological solutions and by their unique operational qualities.
11. The Award can be used in company promotional campaigns.
12. The Gold Police Star Award is granted by the Award Committee – EUROPOLTECH Programme Council, which includes the deputy chief commanders of the police and national security services. The Award Committee can use the advice of experts.
13. Meetings of the Award Committee are closed. The Committee's decisions are final. No appeal on the Committee's decision shall be considered.
14. The Award Committee shall take decisions by a majority vote.
15. The number of awards shall be determined by the Programme Council, individually for each edition of EUROPOLTECH. The Award Committee reserves the right not to grant any awards.
16. The Award Committee can also put forward a motion to Poland's Minister of the Interior and Administration, Minister of National Defence and the Commander-in-Chief of the Polish Police to award additional commendations for the winners of the Gold Police Star Award.
17. The announcement of the results and award presentation shall take place during Europoltech.
18. The results shall be circulated through their publication at www.europoltech.pl and through information sent to trade media partners. The list of winners and the award-winning products shall be published in the EUROPOLTECH 2021 Exhibitor Catalogue.
